

**ORDINANCE 01-18**

**AN ORDINANCE** amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Laurens, Iowa, 2018 by amendment to commercial cardboard recycling rates, landfill rates, and e-waste recycling

BE IT ENACTED by the council of the City of Laurens, Iowa:

The Code of Ordinances of the City of Laurens, Iowa is amended by repealing and replacing Chapter 106.07(1)(A and B), Collection Fees:

Beginning May 16th, 2018 and thereafter:

- (1) The monthly cardboard recycling for commercial facilities are as follows:
  - Minimum pickup - \$7.50 per month
  - Weekly pickup - \$18.00 per month
  - Multi pickup (stops or dumpsters) - \$25.00 per month
  
- (2) In the event water and electricity services are connected, both garbage and landfill fees apply with the following exemptions:
  - Commercial non-users will be charged at a rate of \$5 per month.
  - Unoccupied residential users will be charged at a rate of \$5 per month with no garbage charge.
  - Apartment complexes of less than 8 will be at the rate of \$30 per month.
  - Apartment complexes of 8 or more will be at the rate of \$60 per month.
  
- (3) Stickers for e-waste recycling will be as follows at the rate of \$5 per sticker:
  - up to 13" – 3 stickers
  - 14" – 26" – 4 stickers
  - 27" and up – 5 stickers
  - Computer monitors – 3 stickers
  - Other electronics – 2 stickers
  
- (4) Appliances such as freezers, washers, dryers, microwaves, stoves are at the rate of \$10.

REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or and section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

WHEN EFFECTIVE: This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
